

We travelled in a comfortable mini bus with 22 students and 3 faculty members. All 22 students of final year B.Com, who actively participated in the visit which was successfully coordinated by Prof. G G Patil, Prof. M No Goudar and Prof. A Veena. A brief introduction about industry and how company was established was given by Mr. Ranjan Toranagal. Firstly, we were taken to gowning room and provided with jackets and caps.

Initially he gave us information about the history of Jindal Steel and Power Ltd. JSW Steel Ltd was originally incorporated as Jindal Vijayanagar Steel Ltd on March 15<sup>th</sup>, 1994 at Toranagallu in Ballari, KARNATAKA, the heart of the high-grade iron ore belt and spread over 10,000 acres (40 km) land. It is well connected to both the Goa and Chennai Port. He also said that the JSW Ballari plant is the world's 6<sup>th</sup> largest steel plant and 1<sup>st</sup> largest steel plant in India.

After that we were taken to steel manufacturing area. He explained that, the company has an extensive portfolio of flat and long products and has an export presence across 100+ countries. Further he said that, it is one of the leading producers and exporters of coated flat steel products in India. He also explained about different steps involved in manufacturing of steel in brief. We got the information about different types of products manufactured by using steel. They are Hot rolled coils, Sheets and Plates, Cold rolled coils and Sheets, Thermo-mechanically treated (TMT) bars, Wire rods, Special steel bars, etc.

He said that apart from Steel, company also manufactures Iron, Cement and Power and it has an idea of production to start manufacturing of JSW Paints. Also he explained that, company uses Self Generated Power(electricity) for manufacturing activities and water from Tungabhadra reservoir and also from Alamatti reservoir ( around 245 kilometers through under pipelines from Alamatti to Toranagallu).

We also got information about HR policies of the company. It means how company recruits the people. Generally, company follows four procedures in selection of candidates on the basis of performance in (1) Written Test (2) Group Discussion (3) Technical and HR interview and (4) Physical Fitness Assessment. Company provides employment to 25,000 people, beside direct / indirect employment to two lakh others.

Finally, brief information was given about the CSR policies of the company. He said that, the company has adopted a CSR policy where it strives to address the issues related tfrom antenatal stage of life up to the reproductive age of 45 years theme 'Janam se Janani Tak, JSW Aap ke Saath' through a process of social inclusion. After that plant head Mr. Ranjan Toranagal was felicitated. Lastly, we concluded the visit by clicking a group photograph inside and outside the plant and we moved out from their around 2:30 pm after
